Any incidents should first be reported to the local police and they should be reminded of our CCTV facility, as this may be of help in finding any vehicles that may have been involved in any incident. Records of all vehicle number plates are retained for approximately 14 days before being removed.

George experienced great sorrow in his life with the untimely death of his first wife Jill, the mother of his children, and recently of his daughter Jeni. He felt very blessed with the years of happiness and support during his marriage to Marianne. They were a great team, complementing each other in their joint ventures. George was the original bon viveur with a very big character. Our thoughts are with his family at this very sad time.
